calendar – basic reminder service

SYNOPSIS

calendar

DESCRIPTION

calendar reads a plain text database of appointments in *\$home/lib/calendar*, and prints out lines matching today or tomorrow. On a Friday it prints out all appointments throughout the weekend, and the following Monday. This is a simple reimplementation of the classic UNIX/Plan 9 command of the same name. It does not support all the features of the original version, in particular, *calendar* only understands one kind of date: A capitalized three letter abbreviation of the month followed by a date.

EXAMPLE

date
Wed Jun 6 08:24:47 CES 2019
echo Jun 6      dentist appointment >> $home/lib/calendar
echo Jun 7      psychiatrist appointment >> $home/lib/calendar
echo Jun 8      recuperate... >> $home/lib/calendar
calendar
Jun 6 dentist appointment
Jun 7 psychiatrist appointment
```
