

NAME

rcal – print this months classic Ravtaalian calendar
rrcal – print this months revised Ravtaalian calendar

SYNOPSIS

rcal [*-m*]
rrcal [*-m*]

DESCRIPTION

Much like *cal(1)*, *rcal* and *rrcal* prints a calendar of the current month, but using either the classic or the revised Ravtaalian Calendar of Progress. It cannot print anything other than the current month however. Also, it follows the UNIX convention, where the *-m* flag, sets Monday as the first day of the week rather than Sunday.

In addition to printing a list of dates for the current month, the current Jameldic day (and date) is also printed. This is convenient since *rdate(6)* and *rrdate(6)* cannot print the week day.

BUGS

rcal requires monospaced fonts for correct alignment.
