

**NAME**

*rcal* – print this months classic Ravtaalian calendar  
*rrcal* – print this months revised Ravtaalian calendar

**SYNOPSIS**

**rcal** [ *-m* ]  
**rrcal** [ *-m* ]

**DESCRIPTION**

Much like *cal(1)*, *rcal* and *rrcal* prints a calendar of the current month, but using either the classic or the revised Ravtaalian Calendar of Progress. Unlike the UNIX command *cal(1)*, however, *rcal* does not accept any arguments, except for *-m* which specifies that a week starts on a Monday rather than a Sunday. And it can only print the current day and month.

In addition to printing a list of dates for the current month, the current Jameldic day (and date) is also printed. This is convenient since *rdate(6)* and *rrdate(6)* cannot print the week day.
